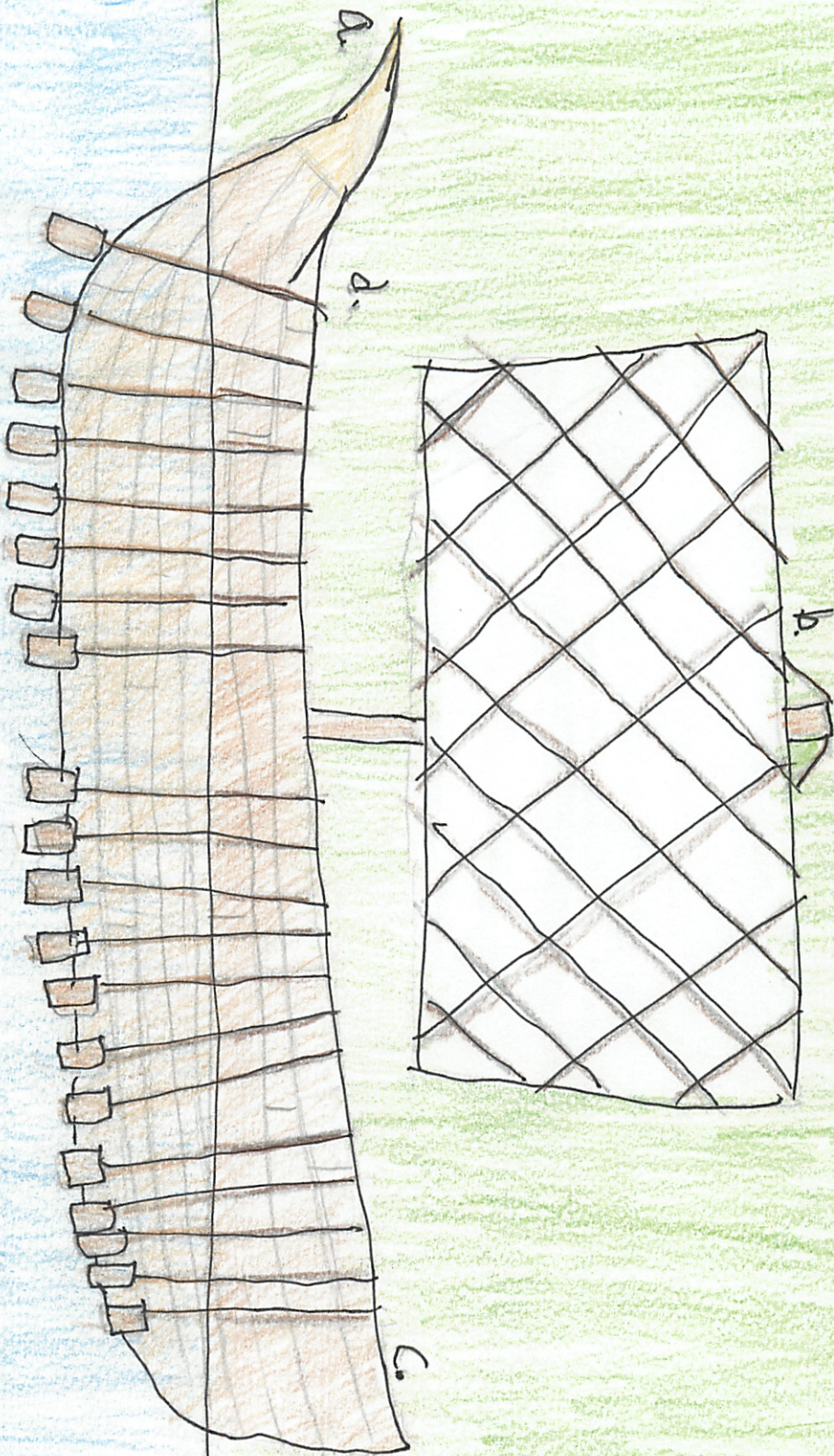

Used to knock a hole in the opponent's ship

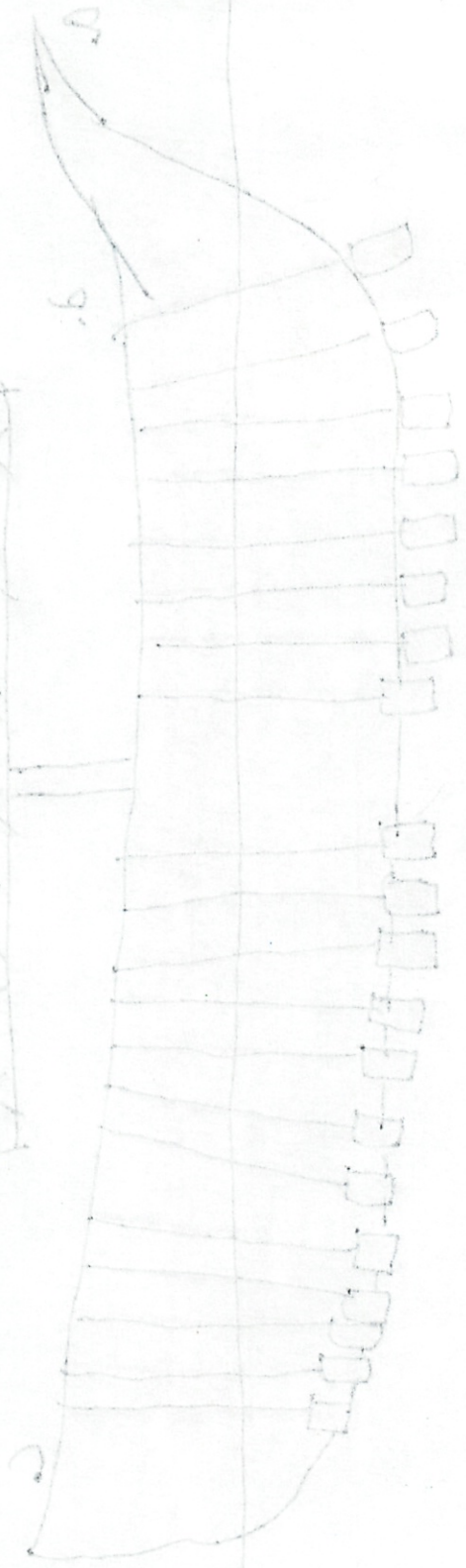
b - sail and mast - used only for long voyages

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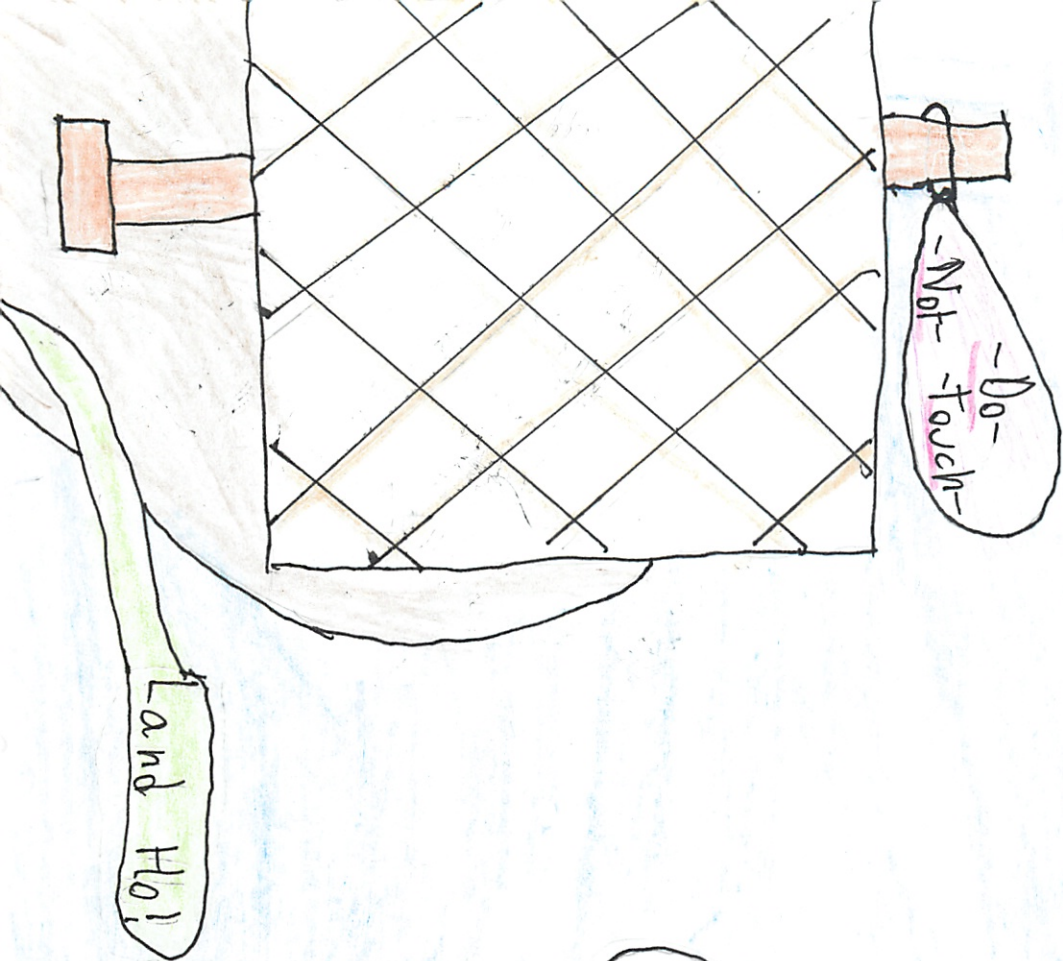

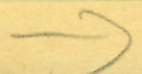
