Yes to some extent. If you work hard you may be rich and famous. If you are a slacker you will most likely not be rich and famous. So the answer is sort of.

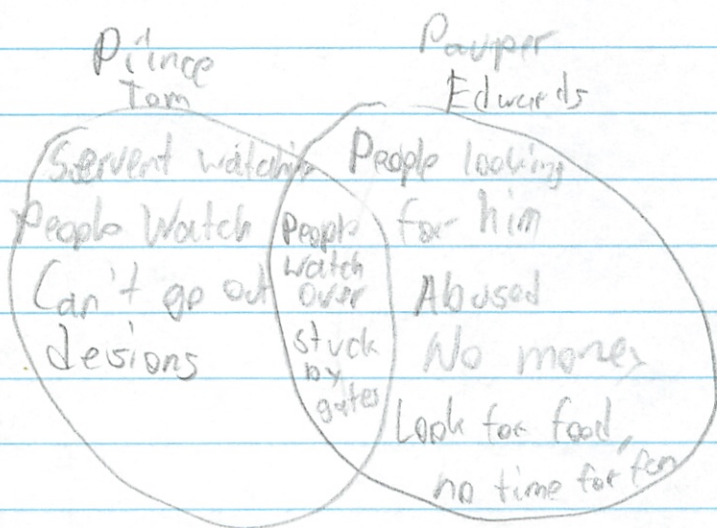
